How to Share the Gospel, AND EVANGELISM VERSES TO HELP YOU

The BIBLE says:

Hebrews 11:6

6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him (God): for he that cometh to God must believe that He Is, and that He Is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.

In other words, salvation is accomplished by:

- a) Believing in God, and in JESUS, His Son;
- b) Asking GOD for salvation, and not trying to earn it by good works.

This is done by saying to God:

THE PLAN OF SALVATION / THE SINNER'S PRAYER

- 1) I am a sinner from the heart, and condemned to an eternity without You, because of it;
- 2) I can't change or do enough righteousness to earn my salvation;
- 3) Would YOU, God, please forgive me of my sins;
- 4) Would YOU, God, please work in me the righteousness of JESUS CHRIST, YOUR PERFECT SON, Who died in my place.

Heavenly Father, make me Your child; be Lord of my life! Save me from my sins!

ALVATION COMES FROM more than mere words; it comes from a sincerely-felt repentance and a belief in/commitment to God in JESUS. It's not just a 'warm, fuzzy,' "JESUS, I accept You as my Saviour!" And it's not just reciting a 4-Step list! The person wishing salvation must be truly sorry for his sins, sick of his sin, and wishing to repent (totally turn from that sin). He must realize that he is unable to change from that sin on his own, and is needing GOD to put the righteousness of JESUS into him. Salvation takes a DIFFICULT LIFE-COMMITMENT decision!

In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea,
 And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
 Matthew 3:1-2

17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. Matthew 4:17

12 And they *(the disciples)* went out, and preached that men should repent. **Mark 6:12**

When your friend is ready to TRULY repent of (turn from) his sin (under God's power) and make JESUS his Lord and Saviour lead him in a prayer similar to the **SINNER'S PRAYER**, above.

Essentially, salvation is as simple as that! Witnessing is very simple if you just remember this **PLAN oF SALVATION** that God has given us. Share it with your friends, using some of the verses in the next few pages to back up what you say. After you memorize many of these verses God will bring back to you the remembrance of them as you explain to your friends the message of the **SINNER'S PRAYER / PLAN OF SALVATION**. And share with your friends your own experience in coming to know JESUS as your personal Saviour; be a witness to them of what God has done for YOU! • HE ROMANS ROAD is the simplest and most complete way to present the Gospel through Scripture. Using verses from just the Book of Romans, you can present the Gospel very quickly, beginning near the start of the Book of Romans, and progressing toward the end.

These should be the first verses the evangelist memorizes. The other verses of Scripture, listed afterward, add details to the ROMANS ROAD:

HE FOLLOWING VERSES from the Bible will help you as you share the Gospel ("Good News") with your friends. The **KING JAMES VERSION** of the Bible is used here because it is the easiest to memorize. If a verse is hard to understand or uses old-fashioned words, look it up in a modern translation and, when using the verse in evangelism, substitute any unusual, old-fashioned words with more modern words that might be easier for others to understand.

UNIVERSAL SINFULNESS

Psalm 51:5

5 Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me.

Isaiah 53:6

6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on Him *(Jesus)* the iniquity of us all.

Isaiah 54:6-7

6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away. 7 And there is none that calleth upon Thy name, that stirreth up himself to take hold of Thee: for Thou hast hid Thy face from us, and hast consumed us, because of our iniquities.

Isaiah 59:2

2 But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid *His* face from you, that He will not hear.

SALVATION ACCOMPLISHED BY GOD, NOT BY US

I Corinthians 1:18

8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

ASSURANCE OF SALVATION

John 1:12,13

12 But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, *even* to them that believe on His Name:

13 Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

John 5:24

24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth My word, and believeth on Him that sent Me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

John 6:37

37 All that the Father giveth Me shall come to Me; and him that cometh to Me I will in no wise cast out.

John 10:28,29

28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand.

THE SINNER'S PRAYER

F YOUR FRIEND is evidently sincere in wanting to repent and make JESUS Lord of their life, be sure to give them an invitation to salvation! Offer to lead them in a prayer similar to the one below. But ensure, first of all, that they are truly sincere in their belief in JESUS, and in their repentance from sin! Preaching repentance is easy for you, but it must be hard for them to truly receive, because JESUS asks their everything! JESUS said, in Matthew 7:14, "FEW there be that find it (*Salvation*)!" So if they aren't truly sincere don't make it overly-easy for them; JESUS didn't! (In fact, in Matthew 13, He actually told us that He preached in parables, to HIDE the Gospel of salvation from the insincere!) Because an insincere new "Christian" whose life hasn't changed will not be honoring to God. And they will also soon fall away. And that will make them far less likely, or even impossible, to genuinely receive Him in the future! So if they are not completely ready to believe in JESUS, and to repent of their sins, be grateful that you have been granted the privilege of 'planting the seed' in them. Pray and trust God to send others, at a later time, to water the seed, and still others to harvest it; you are being Biblical (I Corinthians 3:6-8).

If your friend is truly sincere and repentant you will see a very quick change in their life. They will then, as a tree, grow and blossom into a beautiful likeness of Christ, as they continue to draw closer to God for the rest of their life!
